

2008 NRHA EUROPEAN AFFILIATE CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

Changes as proposed by International Committee 07/07/07.

Increase all dates by one year. Other changes are noted below by highlights. All other conditions remain the same.

QUALIFICATION

3. Owners and qualifying riders must be members of an NRHA affiliate and the NRHA to qualify and show in the Championships. Any monies earned prior to obtaining these memberships will not be counted for qualifying purposes. ← - - - Formatted: Bullets and Numbering
8. The top ten (10) qualified placings plus ties in each class offered during the qualifying period from each country will qualify to attend the Affiliate Championships. ← - - - Formatted: Bullets and Numbering
Deleted:
10. A qualified Youth or Non Pro rider may substitute a horse for the Championships if the qualified horse is deceased or has been sold. In the instance that a horse has been sold, a transfer must be completed with the NRHA office. If a horse is deceased, the original NRHA competition license must be returned to the NRHA office to be marked "Deceased".
