- I. 2001 Rule Changes proposals-
  - a. 34-01-11: Affiliate committee does not support rule change proposal.
  - b. 43-01-11: Committee does not support section 1 & 2 of proposal as written.
  - c. 44-01-11: Committee does not support rule change proposal.
  - d. 49-01-11: Committee does not support rule change proposal. Everyone agreed the NRHA should try to keep the same age range as other large organizations such as AQHA.
  - e. 49-02-11: Committee support rule change proposal.
  - f. 51-01-11: Committee does not support rule change proposal as written, needs clarification.
  - g. 58-01-11: Committee does not support rule change proposal based on budget and potential issues of whether or not a person is being paid or a volunteer.
  - h. 58-02-11: Committee supports rule change proposal.
  - i. 66-01-11: Committee supports rule change proposal.
  - j. 97-01-11: Committee does not support rule change proposal.
  - k. 122-01-11: Committee supports rule change proposal but feels it should be optional, not forced.
- II. Affiliate Agreements- Decided to split up regions within the committee and make phone calls to remind affiliates to send in affiliate agreements and outstanding applications.

- III. Membership Rosters- Looks good so far. Make sure affiliates turn in their rosters 30 days prior to RAF.
- IV. Added Money- Compared added money in NAAC and Ancillary classes. Ancillary classes receive more added money than NAAC.
