Call to Order

Victorian Reining Horse Association (VRHA) Requests

A letter from the Victorian Reining Horse Association regarding their March show, requesting two allowances, was reviewed and discussed.

The first request regarding the trophy was denied, the show is only allowed to deduct the cost of the plate from a donated trophy.

There was consensus that NRHA would donate their 2.5% of the show fees to a wildfire charity in Australia (The other 2.5% is required to go back to the NAA). The VRHA would still have to submit the full 5% to the NRHA Office per normal procedures, and provide full details on where to make the donation to.

There was consensus that any Australian show that wishes to do the same can do so for the first quarter of the show year, up to a certain dollar amount.
